



## Section H: Small Business Subcontracting Plan (For Large Business Only)

### Small Business Subcontracting Plan

In accordance with Public Law 95-507 and FAR 52.219-9, when a large business receives a subcontract in excess of the applicable threshold specified in FAR 19.702(a) on the date of subcontract award, a small business subcontracting plan tailored to the product or service being supplied must be provided to the Oshkosh Small Business Liaison Officer. If an individual subcontracting plan is being provided and the item(s) being supplied are in excess of the applicable threshold specified in FAR 19.702(a) on two different contracts, Oshkosh Corporation must have two plans, each showing the correct contract number. If a commercial subcontracting plan is being provided, a copy of your approved subcontracting plan must be submitted to Oshkosh Corporation annually.

When you have an approved subcontracting plan with Oshkosh, you are required to submit reports semi-annually during subcontract performance (April and October) using the Electronic Subcontracting Reporting System (eSRS). Your Individual Subcontracting Report (formerly SF294) will be reviewed and approved through the eSRS by our Small Business Liaison Officer.
